Proposals are invited from reputable consultants firms duly registered with relevant income/ sales tax authorities who have on active tax payers list having adequate experience in policy formulation and well acquaintance with mineral sector of Azad Jammu & Kashmir (AJK) and Pakistan for the following:

- (i) Formulation of Mineral Policy of AJK;
- (ii) Preparation, review / modification of other legal framework for the mineral sector of AJ&K.
- (iii) Development of a dynamic web portal in order to reflect relevant information at one place to its stake holders (overseas investors, prospective customers, public and private sectors).

The consultancy firm shall be required to make recommendations to improve the performance of mineral sector of AJK within the ambit of AJK's policies and strategies, aiming at making the policy pragmatic and investment-friendly for securing local/foreign private investment.

The consultancy firm is also required to review the prevalent regulatory mineral sector regime of AJK within the policy framework, its implementation, monitoring mechanism, effectiveness / weaknesses and suggest improvements. The consultant shall be required to develop consensus documents of all stakeholders for final approval of Government of AJK.

The proposals will be opened on the same day at 11:30 am in the presence of proposers or their authorized representatives who may choose to be present
